Romano's Macaroni Grill

This new 1,301 sq meter family restaurant facility was designed to incorporate the special layout, exterior and interior theme of the Romano's Macaroni Bar and Grill franchise. The restaurant building was designed with the following major components: Main Entry and Lobby, General Dining Area, Bar and Lounge, Private Function Rooms, Game Room, Kitchen/Prep/Storage and support areas. The facility's Main Dining Area is open continuously from early morning until late evening to serve breakfast, lunch and dinner. The Private Function Area is to be used for banquets and special events. A Game Room with gaming machines will be part of the facility but will operate independent from the restaurant functions. The room's gaming theme was designed with a special design language independent from the rest of the facility. The Game Room shares the Main Entry into the facility but is otherwise separated from the Restaurant and Private Function Areas.
