



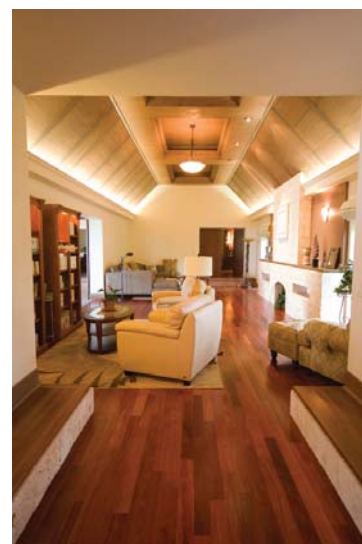

## Minister Residence Restoration

This large 8,000 SF residence originally built in 1929 by renowned architect Hart Wood of Dickey and Wood was also referred to as the Winslow-Farrington House. This historical residence is situated on a large 9 acre lot at the hillside of Pacific Heights. When the owner purchased the residence for their minister housing, the residence required to be retrofitted and modernized to meet their living needs. The restoration work included: enlarging the entry vestibule, added terrace outside the family room, and refinishing throughout. Refinishing included: new wood flooring, wood wall paneling, wall coverings, stone floor as well as stone wall cladding. New light and plumbing fixtures were provided throughout the residence.
